1. Call to Order

Development Committee Chair Fred Levin and Director of Development Amory Sharpe reviewed the department's FY 11 early projections for fundraising as of December 31, 2010 and discussed Capital Campaign planning projections.

a. Approval of Combined City and Foundation Operating Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2011

RESOLVED, That the combined City and Foundation operating budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 for the Asian Art Museum, a copy of which is on file with the finance department, is approved as proposed, subject to final City budget approval.
